

WORKING AT THEBARTON.

Access.

A security system operates on the buildings at Thebarton, access to laboratories must be arranged with G. Kelly, or in his absence the Technician in charge, prior to going there.

Isolated Site.

The Department's laboratories at Thebarton are classified as Isolated Work Sites, and as such work on High Risk Hazards shall not be carried out, unless a second competent person is present.

High Risk Hazards include:-

- Operating equipment or machinery capable of inflicting serious injury.
- Working with exposed energised electrical or electronic systems with powers exceeding 100VA and voltages exceeding 40V.

Working Alone.

A person who wishes to work alone at Thebarton MUST:-

- Have permission from their supervisor.
- Have permission from the Dept safety Officer in liaison with G. Kelly.
- Not work after hours.
- Inform Thebarton office on arrival/departure.
- Work with the main lift-up door open.
- Not operate any hazardous plant eg welding or combustion equipment.
- Have access to a First Aider, and emergency phone numbers.

Working Without Technical staff.

*. 2 competent people must be present.

- 1 person at least must hold a current Senior First Aid Certificate.
- Machine tools in the workshop must not be used.
- Must not work after hours.

Undergraduate Students.

Students who wish to plan their experiment or set up equipment, may do so with prior arrangement with G. Kelly, who will supervise them. Students who are going to carry out experimental work must have a supervisor with them.

After Hours work.

Permission to work after hours will only be given in unusual circumstances.
